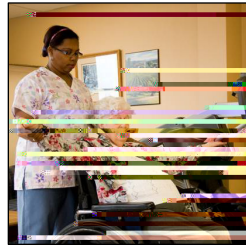


Functional rehabilitation/walking programs involve interventions that assist or promote the person's ability to attain his or her maximum functional potential.

The nursing intervention must exceed routine nursing care and be provided by staff (RN, LPN/RPN, assistant/aide).
